SESSION BREAKDOWN

INTRODUCTION

Use the introduction video to summarise, and support the pupils' expectations of, this session.



In the next 30 seconds, write down or quietly discuss as many words as possible that come to mind when you think of museums.

Ask the pupils to discuss if their views on museums have changed at all. Can they remember what they said during session 1?

- In the next 20 seconds, write down or quietly discuss the skills you've used during this project.
- ACKNOWLEDGING OUR STRENGTHS

DISCUSSION - 5 MINUTES

Ask the pupils to go back into their groups and discuss the strengths of the group.

Every pupil should highlight a positive attribute of one of their peers. It can be spoken or written down.

PROVIDING PROJECT FEEDBACK - 10-15 MINUTES

POST-PROJECT EVALUATION

The pupils should spend 5 minutes filling in the final evaluation for the project. Once all the pupils have finished, the teacher will hand out the pre-project evaluations to each of the pupils. The pupils will be able to see if or how their understanding of museums has changed as well as being able to recognise where their confidence and skills have developed.

Ask the pupils to provide feedback for their local museum. This can be any feedback and provided in any form. The museum will always appreciate letters, videos, photos or social media posts!

CONCLUSION
